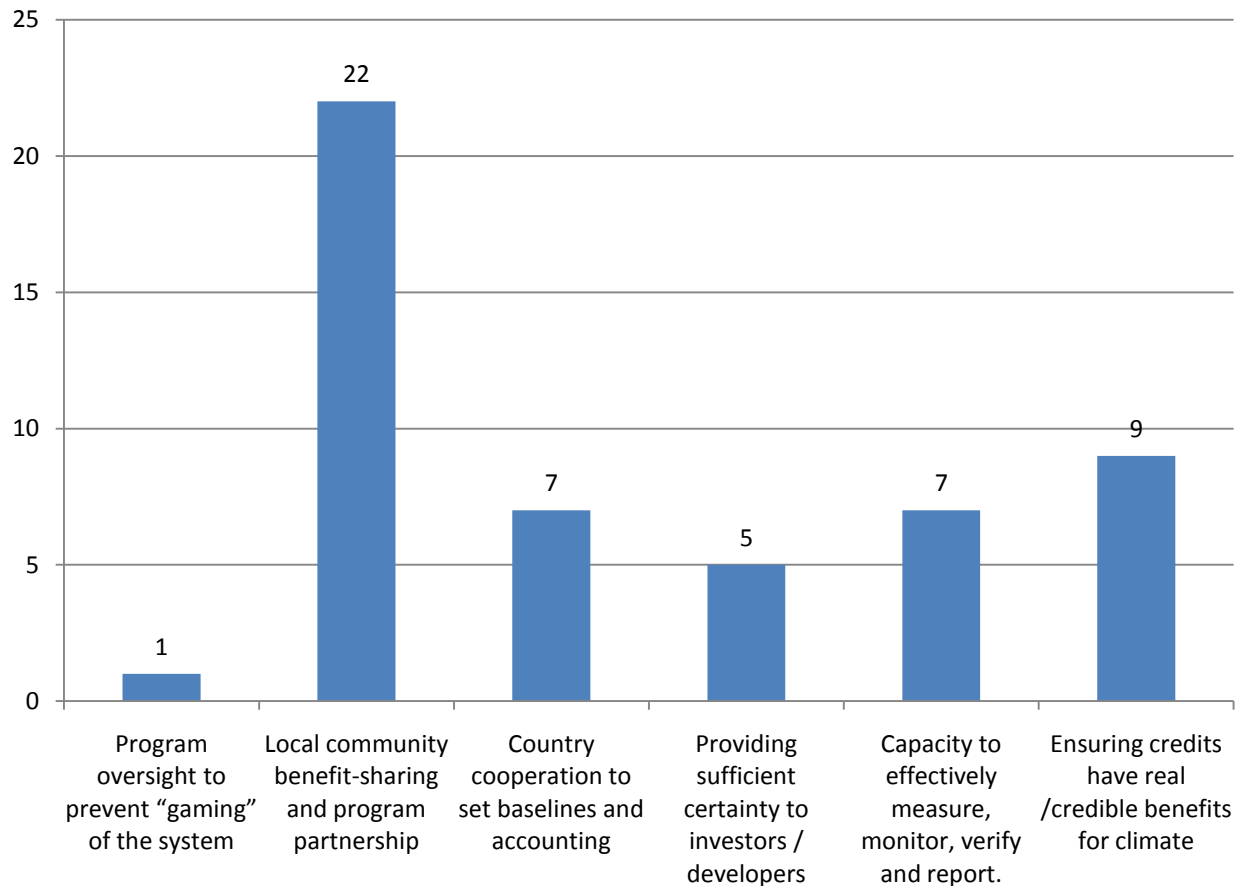
Participants Answer 2 Key REDD Questions
